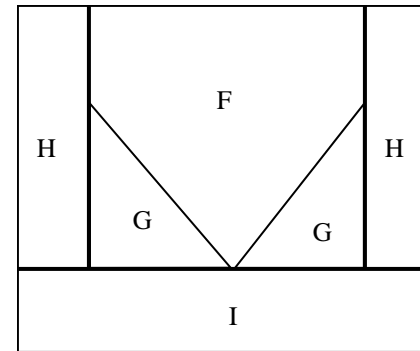
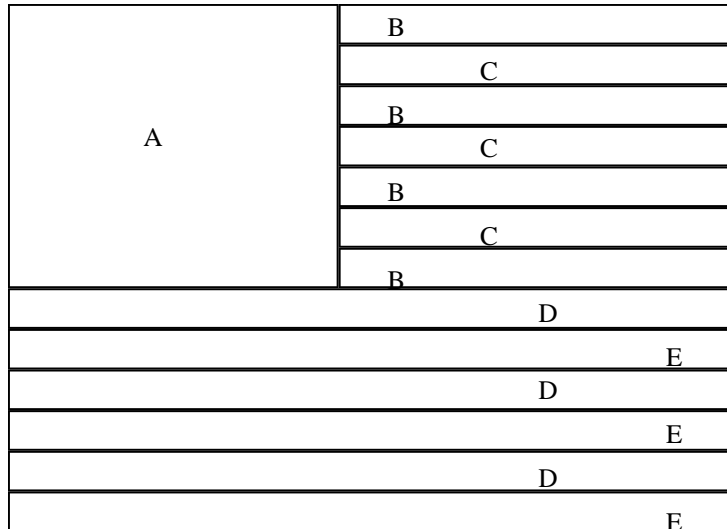


# Home Sweet Home

Row By Row - 2016



## Home Plate

F= White—5" square

G= Tan—(2) 3" squares (add magic corners to 5" white square)

H= Tan—(2) 2 3/4" X 5" (add to each side of white square)

I= Tan—2 3/4" X 9 1/2" (add to bottom of white square)

## Flag

A= Blue Stars—4 1/2" X 4"—cut 1

B= Red—1" X 5 1/2" - cut 4

C= White—1" X 5 1/2" - cut 3

D= White—1" X 9 1/2" - cut 3

E= Red—1" X 9 1/2" - cut 3

Using your green "outfield" fabric and the remainder of your tan "infield" fabric, use the arc on page two of this pattern to create your curved seam. Once you have your curved seam, square your piece to 9 1/2" X 23". Leave approximately 15" of green from the top of the arc for "home" appliqué. Add flag to the top and home plate to the bottom of your row.

Also on page two of this pattern you will find the "home" letters and the "sweet" letters as well as the baseball bat to appliqué on to your row.
